

INTERNATIONAL CLASSIFICATION FOR ATHLETES WITH INTELLECTUAL IMPAIRMENT

Please find below the list of World Para Swimming recognised competitions in the year 2018 which offer international classification.

1. **Copenhagen 2018 World Para Swimming World Series** - to be held on 02-04 March (classification on 27 February-01 March) in Copenhagen, DEN – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 09 January 2018)
2. **Indianapolis 2018 World Para Swimming World Series** - to be held on 19-21 April (classification on 16-18 April) in Indianapolis, USA – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 19 February 2018)
3. **Sao Paulo 2018 World Para Swimming World Series (2018 Caixa Loterias Open Championships)** - to be held on 26-28 April (classification on 23-25 April) in Sao Paulo, Brazil – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 26 February 2018)
4. **Sheffield 2018 World Para Swimming World Series (British Para Swim International Meet)** - to be held on 31 May – 1 June (classification on 28-30 May) in Sheffield, Great Britain – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 2 April 2018)
5. **Dublin 2018 World Para Swimming European Championships** - to be held on 13-19 August (classification on 10-12 August) in Dublin, Ireland – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 15 June 2018).
6. **Jakarta 2018 Asian Para Games** - to be held on 6-13 October (classification on 2-5 October) in Jakarta, Indonesia – (medical documentation must be uploaded before 14 August 2018)

World Para Swimming will update the list should opportunities become available.

Athlete Classification

At competitions where classification is offered, World Para Swimming will schedule athletes based on NPCs submitted priority list pursuant with the below regulations.

An athlete will only be permitted to undergo International Classification if he or she:

- Is registered and/or licensed with World Para Swimming pursuant to the relevant provisions in the World Para Swimming Rules and Regulations;
- Has been entered into the Recognised Competition (must enter a minimum of 1 S and 1SB event) where International Classification is to take place;
- Inclusion in the INAS Classification Master List
- Completion of the Training History and Sport Limitation Questionnaire (TSAL-Q) provided by World Para Swimming

These requirements may be updated, subject to World Para Swimming publication of new classification rules and regulations.

Athletes must be included on the INAS Classification Master List no later than the date of final entry for a Competition.

To be listed on the INAS Classification Master List, Athletes must meet the eligibility criteria defined by INAS.

The TSAL-Q is published on the World Para Swimming website under [Classification](#).

If an Athlete is required to attend Athlete Evaluation, Athletes must arrive at the competition **prior to the start of the classification period**. World Para Swimming will schedule athletes in accordance with the classification period **and not** arrival dates of athletes. World Para Swimming **WILL NOT** entertain any request to change any athlete's classification times. World Para Swimming will publish classification schedules to the [World Para Swimming website](#) and notify NPCs. It is the responsibility of the NPC to inform athletes of classification.
